2) wicket-quickview

It is an opensource software library,It was created to enable partial updates for Apache Wicket as wicket's repeaters don't support partial ajax updates. quickview does the work intuitively with zero learning curve .the package comes with two repeaters ,few reuse strategies and different ways of navigating data like infinite scroll and itemsnavigator.

3) ORM Performance Library

Created library which can be used for ORM like hibernate, It helps in efficiently storing data for fast retrieval/fetch time from database. The library contains different strategies for use cases like

- b) Constant fetch time from database even when the querying is done on a lot of data ,say even when there are millions of rows in table,the fetch time will be nearly the same it was when the table had few rows.
